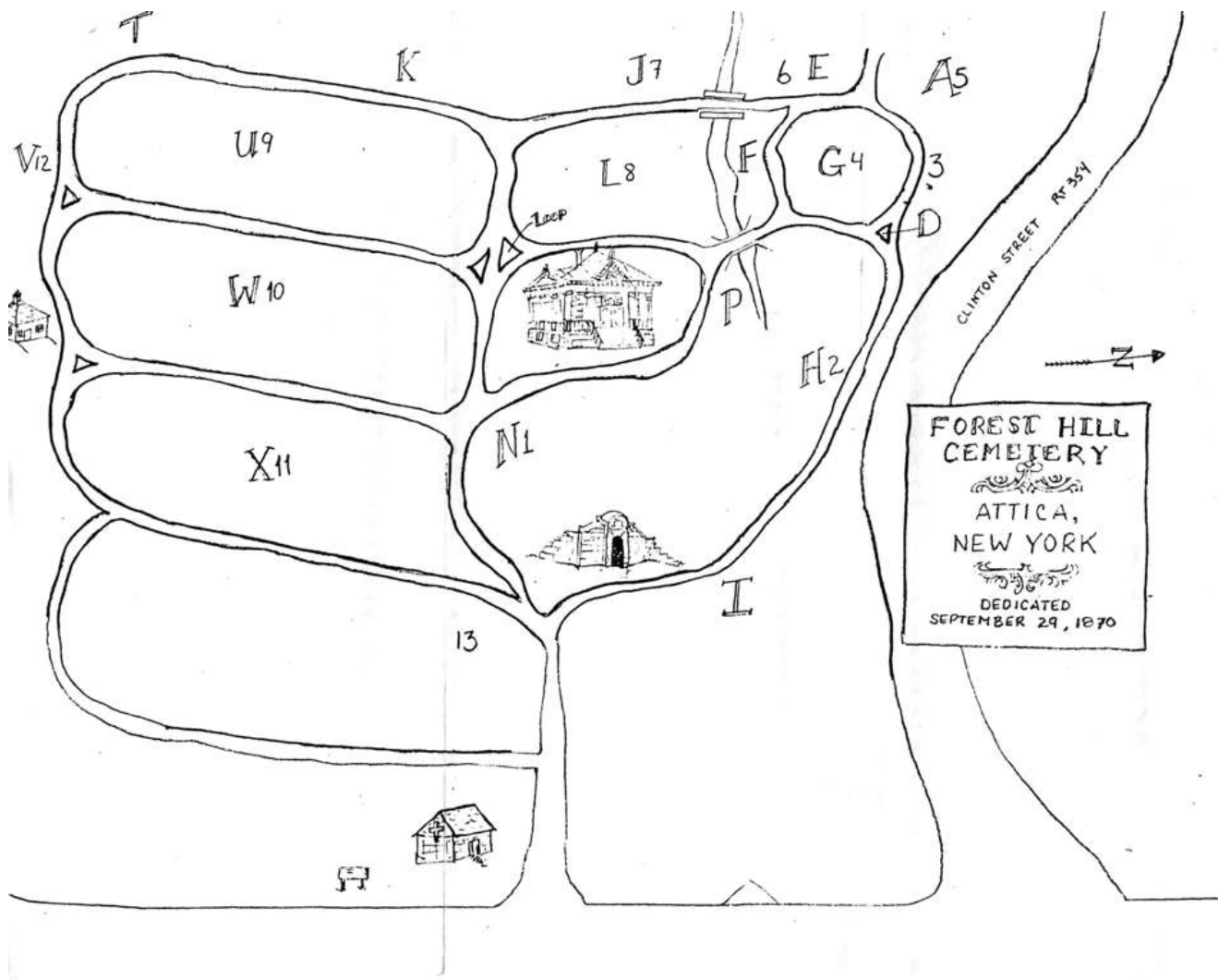

The Forest Hill Cemetery was established in 1868 with the purchase of 12 acres of land from Miss Samantha Gardner. In 1870, bodies were moved from the old cemeteries and private properties and moved to Forest Hill.

The Chapel was built in 1902 and used for many years for funeral services. In 1990, it was restored by the ALPS, which was organized for this purpose. The Chapel is all tin embossed and has a full veranda and wide steps to invite you in. The maps of the plots are in the Chapel as well as a book with the lots designated.
